10 Submissions For ONS Congress 2010

Project Goal/Target audience:

To encourage and support 10 members to submit for either poster or podium presentations at ONS Congress 2010. The target audience includes chapter members interested in submitting a presentation for Congress 2010 and members with presentation experience who are willing to mentor those with little or no experience.

Project Overview:

The purpose of this project is to encourage and support 10 members to submit abstracts for presentation at ONS Congress 2010 through mentorship and workshops. We seek to foster opportunities for shared knowledge and professional mentorship by creating partnerships between advanced practice nurses experienced in presenting with novice nurses who have similar interests. We will promote skill development by hosting workshops for developing a project, writing and submitting an abstract and creating a poster or powerpoint presentation. We will supplement the costs for presentations affiliated with this project with funding from the ONS Foundation. We will also gather qualitative information about the process and experience to help guide future program development.

First time submitters benefit by being guided through the process and experiencing ONS Congress through the exciting new eyes as a presenter. Mentors benefit by sharing knowledge gained from their experiences with their mentees. The chapter benefits by fostering nursing education and promoting community spirit. ONS members attending Congress benefit from the knowledge and education presented. If one idea is presented and can educate even a few nurses to improve care and patient outcomes, consider the possibilities of enhanced patient care if 10 submissions are accepted for presentation at Congress 2010. An investment in this project is an investment in nursing at its best.

Expected Outcomes:

Outcomes include 10 submissions to ONS Congress 2010, the promotion of nursing education and knowledge through presentations, and increased mentorship and partnership opportunities between chapter members.
